## Reimagining the Purpose and Practices of Home Visits

This EEC *Learning Session* includes facilitated courageous conversations and practices based on the following understandings and frameworks:

- Home visits are an extended opportunity to build trusting, developmental relationships. (Framework: Search Institute's *Developmental Relationships*)
- Many families are in a heightened state of stress and crisis. What we say and do, and how we say it may be perceived differently based on the stage of crisis families are experiencing. (Framework: *Therapeutic Crisis Intervention for Schools (TCIS)*)
- There must be a shared understanding of purpose and practices by staff who complete home visits. (Framework: Parent Teacher Home Visit (PTHV))

*Learning sessions are designed for Board Members, Superintendents, Administrators, Teachers, Support Staff, Parents/Caregivers, Child Welfare and Juvenile Justice Stakeholders, Social Justice Advocates, and Community Partners.*
