Nuts & Bolts of School Discipline

(Interactive 6-hour Learning Session)

In the same ways that we invest in teaching content, we must also invest in teaching appropriate behaviors.

This learning session discusses laws, policies, practices, and trends related to K-12 discipline, including due process, non-discriminatory practices, addressing disproportionality, and eliminating the school-to-prison pipeline. Participants will be prepared to advocate for, establish, and sustain fair and transparent discipline processes that contribute to improving educational outcomes and experiences for all students and families.

Appropriate Responses to Child and Adolescent Behaviors

(Interactive 4-hour Learning Session)

This learning session discusses frameworks and strategies to keep students engaged in their learning environments while teaching behavior expectations and developing positive relationships. Participants will learn appropriate responses to behaviors that support a sense of belonging, wellness, and self-regulation, using "teachable moments", community partnerships, prevention and intervention resources, meaningful family engagement, and other strategies.

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A "teachable moment" shifts the focus from the behavior and consequence to the "why" and building relationship and capacity.

Learning sessions are designed for Board Members, Superintendents, Administrators, Teachers, Support Staff, Parents/Caregivers, Child Welfare and Juvenile Justice Stakeholders, Social Justice Advocates, and Community Partners.
